Write a HTML file for a web page that contains the items below. Use an internal style sheet (i.e., a style block) to specify all fonts, sizes, colors, and any other aspects of presentation. Submit your HTML file to the [Homework 21 assignment on Moodle](#).

Your page should contain:

- A header with white text on a dark green background, in Arial font, bold, and centered.
- Two paragraphs of text, each with dark gray text in Tahoma font, on a light blue background, with a dark blue border.
- At least two hyperlinks, with the default link color set to something other than blue.
- An unordered (bulleted) list, with square bullets and left margin set to 100 pixels.
- At least three other items and styles that you want to include. Experiment and have fun!

After creating your page, use the [HTML 5 Validator](#) to check that you have written valid HTML.

You can create your web page in a text editor (such as Sublime, Spyder, Idle, TextEdit, or Notepad). You may wish to create the web page using the [W3Schools "Try It" editor](#) and then save it as an HTML file. In any case, make sure to save your file with a .html extension and open it in a web browser to view the page that you created.
